Photo Exhibition & Walk

Time: 1:30-2:30pm, Date: 21st August

This event consists of a slow walk across the grounds of the Black Castle. There are some smooth
concrete, ramped pathways which are intially accessible, however there are limited pathways up
to the Black Castle itself. There are non-regulatory heritage steps leading both down and up to
the Black Castle and the ground conditions are very uneven.





The walk will last an approximate duration of 1 hour, with lots of stops along the way. There are ten public benches available across the grounds of the Black Castle.

The walk will be guided by two members of Studio idir, and there will be audio recording and photography happening throughout. Please make one of the guides aware if you wish not to be recorded in either of these ways. By bringing along any of your own photographs to share as part of the exhibition, you confirm that you have the permission of any people, or of their guardians, who appear in your photograph, to share the photo with us and for it to appear in the exhibition and online in any associated press or social media.



Car Parking: There is a small car park adjacent to the Black Castle Grounds, with two accessible spaces.

Public Transport and Access: we encourage use of public transport and active travel to get to the Black Castle grounds, public transport however is limited with no direct access to the Castle grounds.

Toilet Facilities: there are no public toilet facilities at the Black Castle. The closest WC is at the Sailing Club, adjacent to the Black Castle Grounds, but it is not guaranteed to be open. The closest changing Places Toilet is available at the Wicklow library, approximately 550m from Black Castle.

Health and Safety: Closest known AED inside Lloyd's Pharmacy, Main Street, Wicklow

Refreshments: There are refreshments available for purchase in Wicklow town, approximately 550m from Black Castle.

The top floor exhibition space can be accessed via a lift and accessible doorway.

Toilet facilities: A changing places toilet is available at the Library.

Refreshments: There are refreshments available for purchase in Wicklow town, approximately 50m from Wicklow Library. Water is available for free at the Library using re-useable containers.
